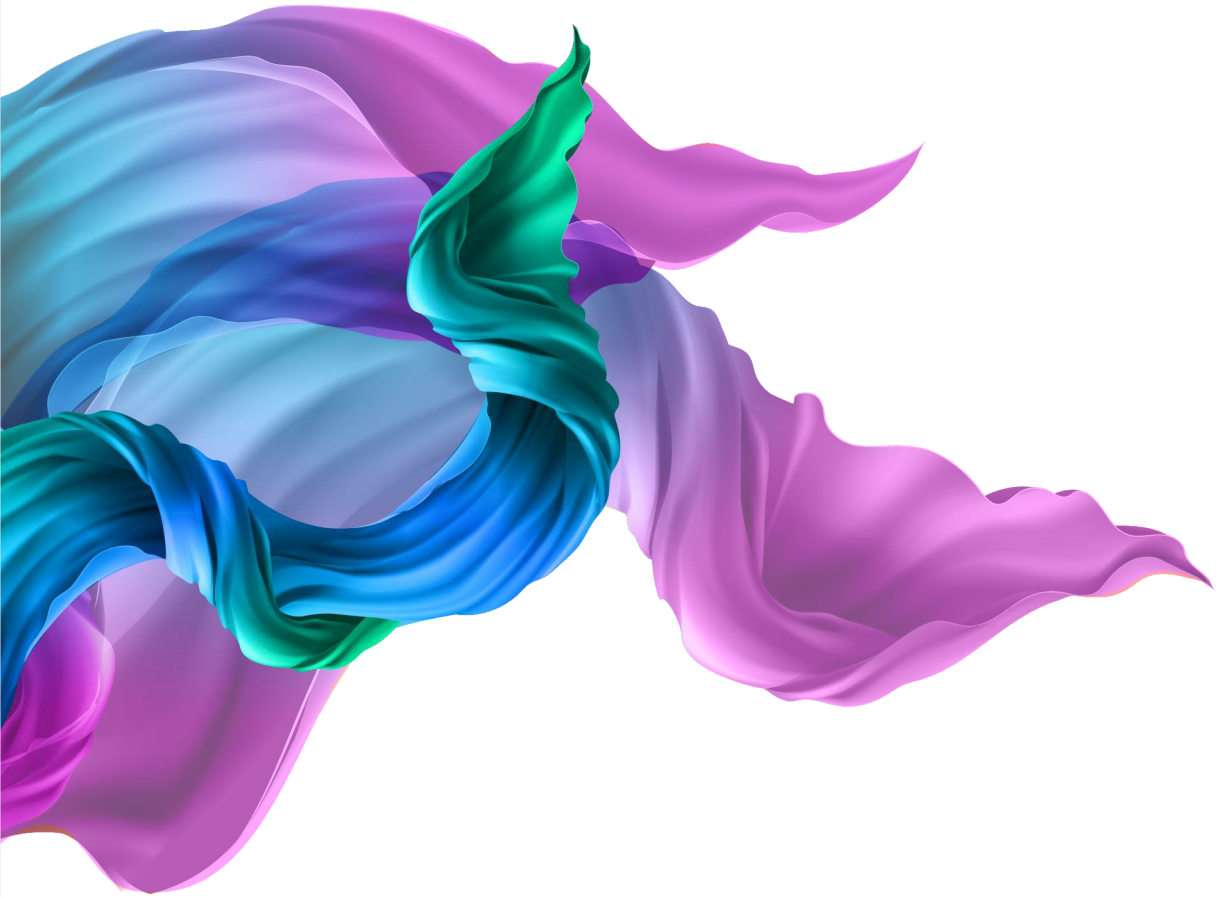

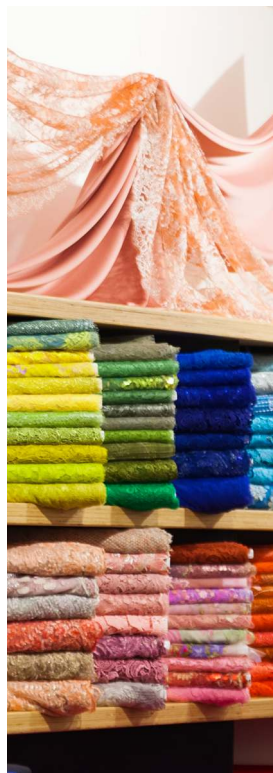

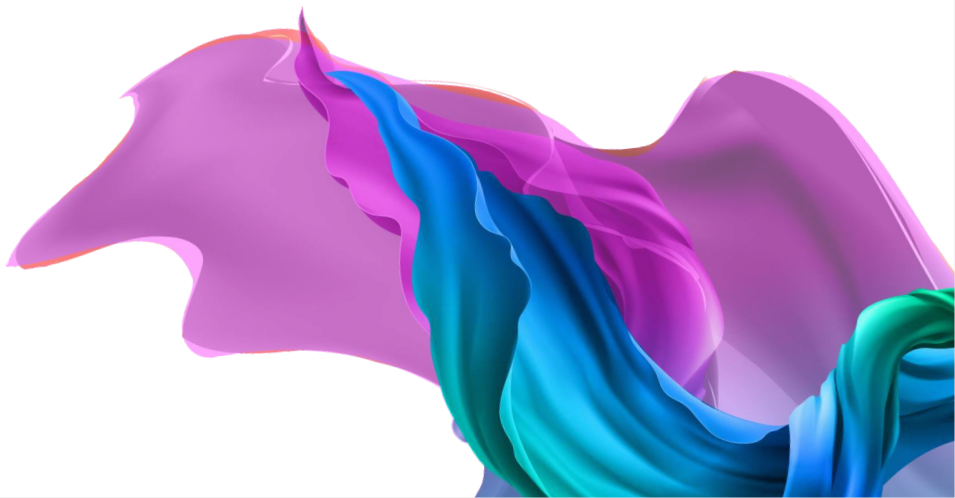
TEXTILE INDUSTRY OF INDIA

- India, manufacturing whole supply chain of textiles, from raw material such as raw cotton, silk etc., yarn to readymade garments, made-ups and technical textiles.
- **Largest producer of cotton & jute in the world.**
- **Second largest producer of polyester, silk & fibre in the world**
- Amongst the top textile producing countries in the world,
- Producing 5680 million kg of spun yarn including 4064 million kg of cotton yarn and 66845 million sq mtr of fabrics
- Indian textile industry has a share of 15% in country's export earnings.
- Textile industry is the second largest employer in India.
- India is having a great potential in export of textile products. India's total export for textile items & garments in the FY 2018-19 is US \$ 38.39 Billion, out of which total export of Cotton fabrics and made ups is 5.94 Bn, Manmade yarn, fabrics & made ups is US \$ 4.98 Bn, Cotton yarn is US \$3.89 Bn.
- Having about 25 lakhs powerlooms all over India with each cluster producing its unique products and vibrant Indian textiles using cotton and blended yarns.
- Technical textiles, gradually gaining market share.
